



June 25 will be an historic day in Omaha. As you already know, the CenturyLink Center will host the first night of swimming of the Olympic Trials, beginning at 6:45 p.m. Right across the street, at 7:00 p.m., TD Ameritrade Park Omaha will host the final series of the NCAA Men's College World Series. Hosting two major sporting events at the same time is tremendously exciting for the city. However, you will need to plan accordingly when it comes to parking for the swimming Trials. Please see below for suggestions on where to park.

In addition to the parking lots at the CenturyLink Center, four alternative parking and traffic options have been identified by local organizers and law enforcement authorities to ensure Olympic Trials ticket holders are in their seat for the 6:45 p.m. start time.

- Downtown parking garages and street parking offer thousands of additional parking spaces within easy walking distance of the arena.
- Metro, the city's bus service, offers 12 routes that provide service within walking distance of TD Ameritrade Park and CenturyLink Center Omaha. Information on bus routes, fares and times are available at www.ometro.com.
- The Mutual of Omaha employee parking lots on Dodge Street between 36th and 38th Streets will be open for Olympic Trials parking. At no cost (yes, it's free!), fans with an Olympic Trials ticket can park and ride a shuttle bus to CenturyLink Center. Six shuttles will run continuously from Mutual of Omaha to the arena from 5 – 7 p.m., and return fans to Mutual from 8 -10 p.m. Mutual of Omaha is less than a three miles from the CenturyLink Center.
- Midtown Crossing will offer parking and shuttle service. Information is available at <http://www.midtowncrossing.com/events/eventshuttle.aspx>. Midtown Crossing is located immediately east of the Mutual of Omaha headquarters buildings (cross streets, 30th and Dodge).

We encourage you to consider the option that works best for you and come early on June 25 to enjoy the opening night of the Olympic Swimming Trials.

Please note: if the College World Series final series is extended to a third game, this will be at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 26. This would mean that the above-listed options would also be in place for parking for June 26.
